



FCDE enters into exclusive negotiations for the sale of its majority stake in Bertin Technologies to Fremman Capital, Chequers Capital and the Management

// The contemplated transaction would mark the culmination of more than three years of an active partnership between FCDE and the management of Bertin Technologies, during which time the Group has been profoundly transformed, expanded its technological footprint and accelerated its development both in France and internationally.

// Under the sponsorship of Fremman Capital and Chequers Capital, Bertin Technologies is entering a new chapter of its development, continuing both its strong organic growth trajectory and its external growth strategy.

FCDE announces that it has entered into exclusive negotiations for the sale of its majority stake in Bertin Technologies (the "Group"), a leading European player in the design and manufacturing of high-technology instrumentation solutions for critical and scientific applications in the photonics, defence & security, nuclear and life sciences industries. FCDE has been the majority shareholder of Bertin Technologies since 2022, alongside the management team and BNP Paribas Développement. The contemplated transaction marks the culmination of a close partnership with the Group's management, during which the Group has significantly accelerated its growth, strengthened its industrial foundations and enhanced its positioning in fast-expanding sovereign markets.

Following the successful completion of its spin-off from the CNIM Group, FCDE and the management team strengthened the organisation and deployed industrial investments that enabled Bertin to deliver a strong organic growth trajectory. The Group also initiated an active acquisition strategy, completing three acquisitions, including two international companies, which have further enhanced its technological capabilities and its strategic presence within European value chains.

Bertin has significantly reinforced its positioning by consolidating and expanding all its product lines. The Group has benefited from very strong commercial momentum, with sharply increasing order intake over the period and a record-high backlog. This trajectory has been accompanied by a marked improvement in financial performance: since FCDE's investment, revenue has more than doubled and EBITDA has tripled, driven by the expansion of high value-added segments and the successful integration of the acquired companies.

With FCDE's support, management has also led several structural initiatives: modernisation of the industrial organisation, stronger integration of subsidiaries and an adjusted governance framework to reflect the Group's scale-up, now firmly established as a leading European platform with international reach. The full renovation and extension of the Aix-en-Provence industrial site, inaugurated in 2025, have modernised and expanded the Group's production base, reinforcing its positioning as an expert in cutting-edge, high value-added technologies.

Under its new envisaged ownership, Bertin Technologies will be ideally positioned to pursue its development, accelerate its international expansion and consolidate its leadership across its strategic markets. The contemplated transaction remains subject to (i) information and consultation of employee representative bodies and (ii) any required regulatory approvals.
