





Lindera completes its second acquisition this year with SIGébène, a specialist in ultra-luxury fittings and contemporary fine cabinetmaking

FCDE announces Lindera's acquisition of SIGébène from its founders, Grégoire and Brigitte Milojevitch. Labeled Entreprise du Patrimoine Vivant (EPV), the company is located in Nogent-le-Roi (28) and has been specializing in contemporary fine cabinetmaking for interior design towards prestigious private clients since 1983. This acquisition is part of Lindera's strategy to strengthen its Lindera Signature offering in the luxury and ultra-luxury sector. Founded by Grégoire Milojevitch and counting now 60 employees, SIGébène has been designing and creating contemporary interior spaces for over 40 years.

Recognized for its expertise in project management, a detail-oriented approach in design, and expertise in finishing craftsmanship, the company has become one of the leading players in fine cabinetmaking by meeting the requirements of its French and international clientele. The second acquisition since FCDE's majority stake acquisition in June 2023 – after the acquisition of Ateliers Muquet in February –, the operation consolidates Lindera's know-how in cabinetmaking, carpentry, veneering, and finishing. SIGébène joins the luxury division of the Group, Lindera Signature, which is already composed of three houses: Technics d'Agencement, La Manufacture and Ateliers Muquet. It thus enriches the Group's offer dedicated to high-end markets with a strengthened specialization in exceptional private residences.

SIGébène has a turnover of approximately 10 million euros, more than half of which being international, and employs a total 60 people in Nogent-le-Roi. Grégoire Milojevitch, founder of the company, will continue to support SIGébène over the coming months, integating it into Lindera Signature and fostering synergies.
